

TEMPORARY WATER SHUTDOWN AND ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

This notice is to inform you that repair work on the watermain that delivers water to your home is scheduled to be temporarily shut down on July 18th, 2024. This temporary water disruption will occur between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM, provided no unforeseen issues arise. The intersection at Meadow Dr/Hillivew Ln S to be closed while the watermain is being worked on.

The contractor will also be installing a portion of storm sewer at the Meadow Dr/Hillivew Ln S intersection. This work will also close the intersection while the storm sewer is being installed. This work is scheduled for July 19th, 2024

During the work the contractor will shut down the intersection at 7:00 AM and will have the intersection opened up at the end of each day. Residents will need to move their vehicles out of the Meadow Drive loop and park on Loretto Street if they need to get out during these days. Access back into the loop will be provided at the end of each day. No access will be provided out of the Meadow Dr loop after 7:00 AM until the end of the day.

Following water disruptions, residents may experience a discoloration in the water during the first use after the water is turned back on. This discoloration is due to mineral deposits that have settled out of the water over time. This water is safe to drink, but the City recommends that you run an outside faucet, or a basement faucet (cold water preferred) until discoloration is gone. This will prevent the mineral deposits from being run through water heaters, washing machines or faucet filters which may result in the clogging of those items.
